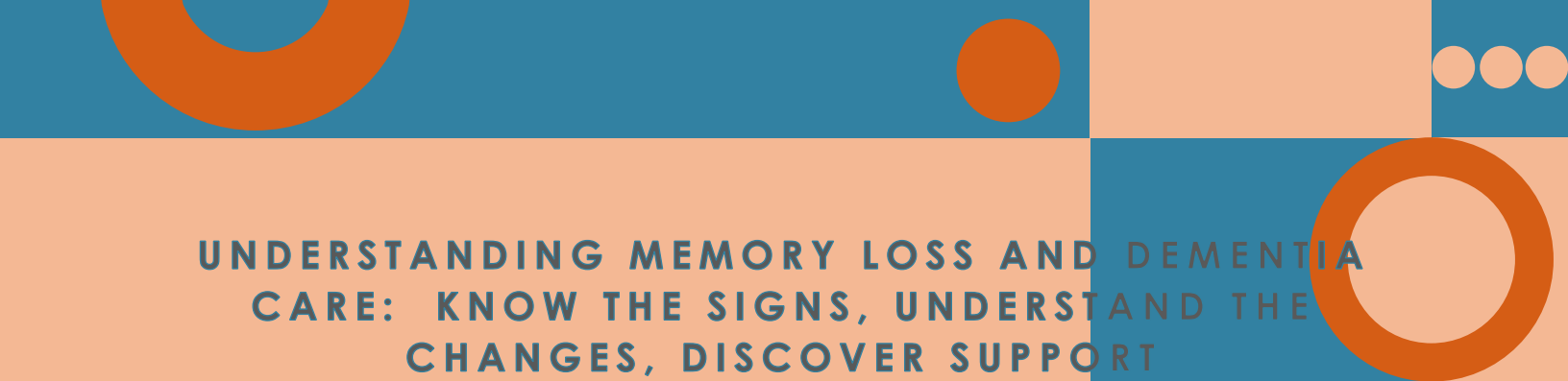

- **The GUIDE Program (Guiding an Improved Dementia Experience):**
 - Available to Medicare participants
 - Provides coordinated care and support services at no additional cost for people with dementia and their unpaid caregivers
 - Benefits include:
 - a dedicated professional to coordinate clinical and non-clinical care
 - 24/7 support line for urgent questions or care concerns, access to support groups, educational resources, and skill-building sessions
 - Respite care and financial coverage for eligible caregivers
 - Help finding local assistance for health-related social needs
- **Alzheimer's New Jersey: Understanding Memory Loss:**
 - Discusses the difference between normal age-related memory changes and abnormal changes that are associated with Alzheimer's disease and other types of dementia
 - Reviews the importance of receiving a thorough diagnostic evaluation when symptoms first arise, current treatment options, and research regarding healthy aging
