

ORDINANCE NO. 02-2024

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL EMERGENCY
APPROPRIATION N.J.S. 40A:4-53**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of East Hanover, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53 (Ch. 169, P.L. 1960 as amended), the sum of \$439,150 is hereby appropriated for Reassessment of Real Property (as ordered by the Morris County Board of Taxation) and shall be deemed a special emergency appropriation as defined and provided for in N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53 and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-55.

The authorization to finance the appropriation shall be provided for in succeeding annual budgets by the inclusion of at least 1/5 of the amount authorized pursuant to this act (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-55).

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.
