

**TOWNSHIP OF EAST HANOVER

ORDINANCE NO. 20-2024

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 79, FEES AND LICENSES, SECTION 79-11, FEES UNDER CHAPTER 132, STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST HANOVER

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has determined the need to amend the schedule of fees for the provision of traffic protection for construction and maintenance work on streets and sidewalks within the Township or abutting thereon; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has also determined the need to amend and supplement the schedule of fees for other instances in which an individual or entity may require the services of an off-duty uniformed police officer for security, crowd control or other purpose deemed valid by the Chief.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of East Hanover, New Jersey, that Chapter 79, Fees and Licenses, § 79-11, Fees under Chapter 132, Streets and Sidewalks, of the Code of the Township of East Hanover, shall be amended and supplemented as follows:

D. Where a uniformed police officer shall be required pursuant to § 132-28 of the Code of the Township of East Hanover, the following schedule of fees shall apply:

~~(1) For Monday through Friday, exclusive of holidays, and between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., the individual or entity requiring the service shall pay 85% of Patrolman Grade I overtime rate per hour. Where a fractional part of an hour is required, the fee shall be rounded to the next higher half hour increment.~~

~~(2) For all other times, t(1)~~The individual or entity requiring the service shall pay Patrolman Grade I overtime rate per hour. Where a fractional part of an hour is required, the fee shall be rounded to the next higher half-hour increment.

E. Where an off-duty uniformed police officer shall be required for security, crowd control or other purpose deemed valid by the Chief of Police, except as set forth in Subsection F below, the following schedule of fees shall apply:

~~(1) For Monday through Friday, exclusive of holidays, and between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., the individual or entity requiring the service shall pay 85% of Patrolman Grade I overtime rate per hour. Where a fractional part of an hour is required, the fee shall be rounded to the next higher half hour increment.~~

~~(2) For all other times, t(1)~~ The individual or entity requiring the service shall pay Patrolman Grade I overtime rate per hour. Where a fractional part of an hour is required, the fee shall be rounded to the next higher half-hour increment.

F. Where an off-duty uniformed police officer shall be required for security, crowd control or other purpose deemed valid by the Chief of Police, and the individual or entity requiring such service is or is sponsored by an East Hanover charitable organization, the East Hanover Board of Education, the Township of East Hanover, or the Hanover Park Regional Board of Education, the P.B.A. may, at its discretion, agree to a rate

of compensation as follows:

G. Minimum fees.

(2) Once an officer has reported to the job site, the minimum fee for service shall be four hours' compensation, plus overhead; provided, however, that in any case where the officer is required to work more than four hours, the minimum fee for service shall be ~~seven~~ eight (8) hours, plus overhead.

(4) For services provided under Subsection F of this section, the minimum fee for services shall be two (2) hours' compensation plus overhead for the Township of East Hanover, East Hanover Board of Education.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudicated, and the remainder of the ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
