A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST HANOVER, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY ACCEPTING THE BID OF AND AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR THE NJDOT FY2023 KLINGER ROAD IMPROVEMENTS (PHASE II) TO D&L PAVING CONTRACTORS, INC.

WHEREAS, the Township of East Hanover (the “Township”) determined that it is necessary to perform certain improvements to Klinger Road in the Township of East Hanover all as set forth in the Specifications for NJDOT FY2023 Klinger Road Improvements (Phase II), Project No.: EHT0081 (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Township advertised and accepted bids for the Project, and on Thursday, March 13, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. the Township opened and reviewed ten (10) bids as follows:

* Mathematical errors were found in Stanziale Construction Inc.’s bid proposal. An incorrect total of \$791,975.97 is shown in the bid proposal. The correct total of \$814,873.97 is shown above.

WHEREAS, the Township and the Township Engineer reviewed the bid of the low bidder, D&L Contractors, Inc. (“D&L”) and determined that same is conforming. The Township and the Township Engineer have further determined that the D&L bid is the lowest responsive bid and that D&L has the ability to perform the services necessary for the Project in accordance with the bid specification; and

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2025, the Mayor and Council of the Township of East Hanover passed Resolution No. 99-2025 pursuant to which the bid of D&L was accepted and a contract was awarded to D&L in the incorrect amount of \$745,430.89 where the correct amount of the D&L bid was \$754,430.89; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the error contained in Resolution No. 99-2025, as set forth above, the D&L bid in the amount of \$754,430.89 remains the lowest responsive bid submitted for

the Project.

WHEREAS, the Chief Finance Officer has certified the availability of funds for the contract amount, not to exceed \$754,430.89.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Township of East Hanover that the Township of East Hanover hereby accepts the bid of D&L Contractors, Inc. and awards a contract for the NJDOT FY2023 Klinger Road Improvements (Phase II) in the total amount of \$754,430.89 in a form acceptable to the Township. This contract is subject to the provisions of the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et. seq. D&L Contractors, Inc. is required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et. seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27, Affirmative Action Regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract is subject to all of the contingencies and requirements set forth in the bid request documents, a copy of which are incorporated herein by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Township Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the Township subject to review and approval of the Township Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Resolution No. 99-2025 is hereby declared null and void and of no force and effect.

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST HANOVER AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST HANOVER CHIEF OF POLICE TO EXECUTE THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON BEHALF OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST HANOVER AND THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST HANOVER POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ESTABLISH JOINT PARTICIPATION IN THE ARRIVE TOGETHER PROGRAM TO ENHANCE AND SUPPORT RESPONSE TO CERTAIN BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CRISIS CALLS

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) has been proposed between participating Morris County Police Departments (“PPD”) and The Mental Health Association of Essex/Morris, a Mental Health Service Provider (“MHSP”) to establish joint participation in the ARRIVE Together Program (the “Program”) to enhance and support response to certain behavioral health crisis calls, and to confirm the mutual understanding and intention of the Parties as set forth in the MOU; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 30:4-27.1, et seq. (the “Screening Law”) and N.J.A.C. 10:31-1.1, et seq. (the “Screening Regulations”), it is the policy of the State of New Jersey to provide for a public mental health system that delivers treatment consistent with a person’s clinical condition, and that screening services be developed as the public mental health system’s entry point in order to provide accessible crisis intervention, evaluation and referral services to persons with mental illness, to offer persons with mental illness clinically appropriate alternatives to inpatient care, and, when necessary, to provide a means for involuntary commitment to treatment; and

WHEREAS, the Parties to the MOU, including the Township of East Hanover Police Department and the Township of East Hanover, recognize the importance of ensuring the safety of every person involved in civilian-law enforcement interactions, and that many of the negative outcomes that have resulted from such interactions may stem from law enforcement officers responding to situations involving individuals experiencing behavioral health crises; and

WHEREAS, the MHSP has been designated by the New Jersey Department of Human Services (“DHS”) to provide screening and other mental health services in accordance with state law and regulations, within the County being served by this MOU; and

WHEREAS, the Screening Law provides officers and screeners with the legal authority to transport or authorize transport of individuals who are experiencing a behavioral health crisis to an emergency department for a full assessment where appropriate; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers may request the assistance of mental health specialists when responding to emergency service calls that relate to behavioral health crises and mental health personnel may request assistance from officers when providing follow-up; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to improve the outcomes in law enforcement’s response to emergency behavioral health crisis calls, to divert individuals in crisis from unnecessary entry into the criminal justice system, and to more efficiently employ the resources of both the PPD and the MHSP as they respond to calls for service, the Parties seek to establish the Program; and

WHEREAS, the MOU is intended to memorialize the relationship and delineate the responsibilities of the Parties in this cooperative joint effort.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of East Hanover, County of Morris, State of New Jersey that the Chief of Police of the Township of East Hanover and the Township Clerk are authorized to sign the Memorandum of Understanding on behalf of the Township of East Hanover.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase in this resolution is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution.
